28 – 31 weeks	<p>Continue to review or remind them to complete MY PREGNANCY CHOICES & PLANNING MY PREGNANCY</p> <p>Encourage them to complete the MY LABOUR AND BIRTH section for the next appointment</p> <p>Document on Epic if they have the app/paper version and any discussions you have had</p>
34 weeks onwards	<p>Review MY LABOUR AND BIRTH section</p> <p>Show them CARE FOR BABY & MYSELF section and advise them to complete before their first postnatal visit</p> <p>Document on Epic if they have the app/paper version and any discussions you have had</p>
At each postnatal visit	<p>Review CARE FOR BABY & MYSELF section</p> <p>Document on Epic if they have the app/paper version and any discussions you have had</p>
